



## Group Tours

### At Four Mile Historic Park

Four Mile Historic Park's 12-acre site serves as a portal into Denver and the West's pioneer past. The Four Mile House, a Denver landmark, is the centerpiece of the park, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. For groups of 10-25 individuals, a tour of the Four Mile House Museum with Q&A will be given by a knowledgeable museum docent, followed by a self-guided tour of the grounds. Guests will learn about Four Mile Historic Park, the Four Mile House Museum, and local history.

**Please note:** Group Tours and rates are only honored if you have reserved your tour a minimum of two weeks in advance. No exceptions. Call 720-865-0803 to make your reservation.

#### FEE SCHEDULE & PROCEDURES

- Tours last approximately 45 minutes.
- Group Tours are available between 10am and 2:30pm.
- Due to the park and museum's historic nature, areas may present some mobility restrictions. The Four Mile House Museum is not stroller, wheelchair, or walker accessible. Please call for specifics and alternative programming options.
- Admission:
  - Adults: \$4.00 each
  - Seniors (65+) or Military (w/ID): \$3.00 each
  - Youth (7-17): \$2
- Minimum 10 people, maximum of 25 people. For groups with more than 12 people, you will be split into two groups for the tour portion of your visit
- Must be reserved at least two weeks in advance
- Deposit of \$30 must be paid at the time reservation is made.
- Remainder of group tour admission is due upon arrival.
- Cancellations must be made at least two weeks in advance for refund. Cancellations made 0-14 days prior to scheduled group tour forfeit the deposit.
